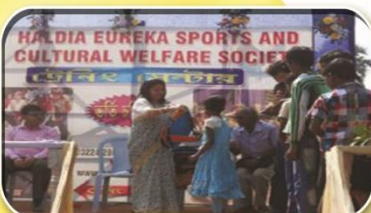

Eureka's Grand Success

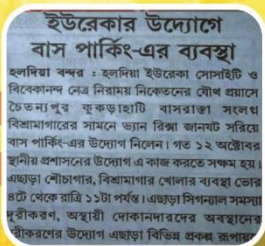
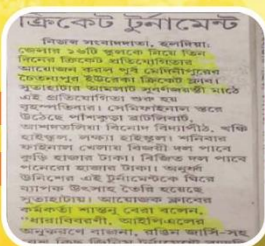

NGO Eureka finances surgeries of poor and deprived patients using a fundraising network. The platform provides visibility of poor patients and builds a personal and trusted bond between patients and donors while ensuring complete transparency.

WHAT IS THE PRESSING ISSUE?

People living in rural areas, these deprived classes cannot afford the proper healthcare or even undergo medical treatments. Several hospitals took the stand, and offered free treatments, but the queue for such hospitals are in millions, leaving behind millions without medical treatment. Patients' are put on waiting list, and in some cases, expire before their turn comes. There are even very few health insurance options, and the poor are not financially able to afford such expensive insurances. The entire cost of treatment, includes blood tests and post medicines are above the pay grade of an average poor. Also, there is lack of medical professionals and facilities provided by the government leading to middle to lower class, deprived of basic medical facilities. Limited number of facilities and healthcare at government hospitals is also another pressing issue, which has led to poor classes to depend on NGOs and trust for their medical treatments.

SHG Group Training to strengthen women's economically

Self-help groups are formed with the help of village girls & Women's in the proper guidance of eureka to uplift them economically. We conduct a well-equipped training program in collaboration with Tata Chemicals to make jute accessories. They have become self-reliant by making jute bags and rugs. After training period they make & sell some of the bags to companies who needed them. The girls are being trained in fishing and fish farming also



Establishment of Bus Parking (Chaitanyapur-Kukrahati Road)

In collaboration with Vivekananda Mission Ashram, & Eureka, a joint venture bus parking Shed was arranged at the rest Yatris & Bus driver, helpers, conductors at Chaitanyapur.

Help to Cancer Patients

Providing nutrition to the illness-affected, especially children, is one of the most effective ways of fighting cancer so we contributed some nutritious fruit packet every year & also helped Rs. 5000 to twenty cancer patients for a total of Rs. 1 lakh, a little contribution most needy patients.

No Plastic Bag Day Programme

Dance Training Centre

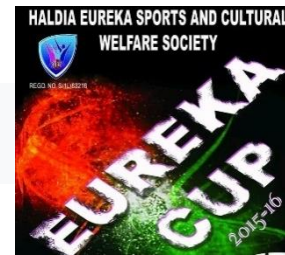
We made a Kathak Dance training Center with the backward poor miserable girls presenting the art of dance & different real instances or story & freedom of expression through dance at various local events.

Description

Donation Drive of Sanitary Pads in Schools & Slums of Haldia

The economic crisis that has arisen due to COVID-19 has created challenges for girls in the slums around Haldia. Lack of access to sanitary pads has led to health and hygiene problems like UTI's and Endometritis that not only cause daily discomfort but can also lead to cervical cancer, fibroids, and cysts that are often left unattended. The psychological impact of not being able to function during their period cycle not only damages the mental health of girls but impedes on their education as many of them drop out of school.

To address these issues, the Haldia Eureka in collaboration with local authorities put in place a project to not only donate sanitary pads to girls but also explain the importance of using them. The cost of 6 pcs of "Stayfree /Whisper Name of Sanitary Pad" (locally produced hygienic sanitary pads) required for one menstrual cycle of one girl is Rs rate 31 /-. The Haldia Eureka aims to provide 4.5 lakhs (450000) sanitary pads free of cost to more than 1000 poor women's in COVID affected slum areas of Haldia Sub-Division.



Target People:

Local High School Girl Students (age 15-19) (Target 15 Schools)

Local Women & girls of rural & slum areas (age 20-35)

Wife's of low salary scale worker who worked in Company (Approved by General Manager of the partner Company)

Project Activities-

Awareness Programme-

Video Campaign in School & Local Slums-

We planned a session of 100 girls in every high school. Participant will watch a film on menstruation & use of sanitary napkin in every session. There will be 2-3 session in every School also there will be a video session in every slum in the nearby company location.



Pamphlets& Poster Distribution in School & local slums to attach in house

A FAQ Booklet & Pamphlets, covering the topics related to reproductive health focusing on adolescence, menstruation-related issues, gender issues and female foeticide. Each adolescent girl attending the session was provided with the booklet. The FAQ booklet functioned as a ready reckoner and reinforced the information provided during the session. Besides, it is handy and compact, and can be referred to at a later time. One or two copies were provided to the school to be placed in the library for wider reading by other girls, teachers and staff members. Pamphlet will give to girl students so they can convey the information to their houses and they can teach their mother who were unaware of these facts.



Taking oath-

There will be an oath taking after the session end

“I promise that I will incorporate the learning’s from this session into my everyday life. I will also share the information with my mother and at least two friends.”

The reason for the making the students take this pledge is to reinforce behaviour change and ensure that they remember the information.

Awareness Program in Slums

There will be a door to door survey & awareness-camp in the slum is of Haldia Sub Division. It will be a personalised one to on direct communicative awareness program. Every day 50-60 women’s will interact with our volunteer.

Then according to survey, they will shortlist the names according to their economic condition.

“Tum Mujhe Khoon Do, Main Tumhein Azadi Dunga”

— a slogan given by our legendary freedom fighter leader **Netaji Subash Chandra Bose** echoes in our minds even today. But in today's context when we are already 'azaad' — the slogan needs to be recalled when we need to collect and donate the precious human blood for including the most wanting needs of our soldiers from the defense and the paramilitary forces and the poorest of the poor who in utmost dire needs of the time can't even buy a drop of blood. Just one unit of the blood has the potential of saving three or even more lives. Besides, it is good both for the heart as well as the liver and not only lowers the risk of cancer but covers up to an extent for loss of a work-out too!

It was a great pleasure to organize the **Biggest Blood Donation Camp** & the first in ever as its kind at Durgachak Stadium/ ITI Government College, Haldia.



In a way, it is also an opportunity of a primary medical examination of each potential Blood donor as all the donors are thoroughly and carefully checked for Blood Pressure, Weight, Height, BMI (Body Mass Index), Haemoglobin level, Blood Sugar, Malaria, Hepatitis B & Hepatitis C, Syphilis, Rh Typing and Blood Grouping, HIV I & HIV II so we arranged a free medical check-up also with blood donation.

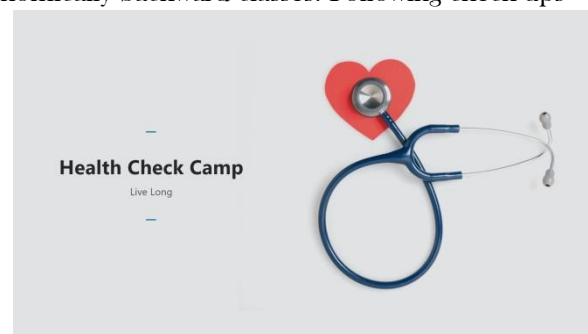
